RESOLUTION FY16-06

A RESOLUTION FOR TEMPORARY EMERGENCY RELIEF FOR UTILITY BILLING OF WATER AND SEWER CUSTOMERS

WHEREAS, the current Code of Ordinances had not been appropriately followed for utility billing practices, in October 2015 our new city employee with the assistance of LGS corrected and began following code as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cold Bay received concerns and complaints from its businesses regarding utility billing from October 2015 – December 2016; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cold Bay wishes not place undue burdens on its customers; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cold Bay has issued a temporary stay on prior practices, the City Office is instructed to give credits on utility bills from October 2015 – December 2015 on the water and sewer portion of bills only, to bill according to prior practice until customers are notified of necessary rate changes and utility service agreements that will be occurring with the start of the new fiscal year of July 1, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City of Cold Bay by this resolution certifies that it will be issuing credits to water and sewer utility customers from October 2015 – December 2015, will be continuing according to prior practice until new rate changes and utility service agreements come into effect for the new fiscal year starting July 1, 2016:
