**RESOLUTION NO. 17-02**

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE 2016 REGULAR COUNCIL ELECTION FROM BY-MAIL TO POLLING-PLACE, AS PER COLD BAY MUNICIPAL CODE 9.66.150(A)

**WHEREAS**, City of Cold Bay Municipal Code 9.66.150(A) indicates that city elections will be conducted by mail unless otherwise changed by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, previous regular municipal elections have been held as polling-place elections, as opposed to by-mail elections and for the sake of consistency due to open ballots for write in's the Cold Bay City Council wishes to continue this practice for the 2016 Regular Election; and

**WHEREAS**, the city clerk facilitates Borough Election the same day as City Election would be held

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF COLD BAY, ALASKA:**

That the City of Cold Bay 2016 Regular Municipal Elections shall not be held as by mail elections, as indicated in Section 9.66.150 of Municipal Code; but instead as a polling place election in accordance with Cold Bay Municipal Code Chapters 9.67 and 9.68.
